

Farmers Market at Sandpoint

Guidelines for Food Vendors

updated 4/03/09

1. A vendor is considered a food vendor as opposed to a farm market member if the gross amount of annual food sales exceeds 20% of the gross sales.
2. Food vendors are considered limited members of the market. Food vendors do not have voting rights. As limited members, food vendors will not be required to serve on a committee.
3. Food must be prepared by the vendor.
4. All vendors are responsible for complying with state and local requirements for obtaining all permits, licenses and/or inspections applicable to their product.
5. Food vendors with a non-certified kitchen may only sell baked goods, jams, and jellies. Food requiring refrigeration may not be sold. Wild crafted mushrooms and sprouts may not be sold.
6. All vendors selling prepared foods are required to display a list of ingredients for each product. Vendor contact information must also be available. Commercial kitchens must also follow all Panhandle Health regulations. Please contact the Panhandle Health District or market manager for more information. Bake sales are exempt.
7. Food vendors' booth sizes are a maximum of 10'X10'. The market manager will assign spaces.
8. All markets, Wednesdays and Saturdays, are open to food vendors.
9. Food vendor fees will be \$25.00 plus 6% commission for one Wednesday or Saturday market or a season fee of \$50.00 and 6% commission on sales from each market.
10. Food vendors are required to follow and abide by all of the rules and regulations of the "Farmers Market at Sandpoint".
